

Module Variations

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Module Variations allow for the individual styling of each module within a position, without it being global. Code wise, this is achieved by adding a class into the module code which loads from the **Module Class Suffix** field in the Module Manager. The theme CSS adjusts accordingly.

Enter any available suffixes at **Extensions** **Module Manager** **Module** **Module Class Suffix**

There are 11 suffixes: **tab1-3**, **bg1-3**, **underline**, **number** and **flush**, **flushtop**, **flushbottom**.

The **Tab** suffixes add a solid background image behind the header, in the shape of a tab. The **B G**

suffixes change the color of the module background only.

Underline

simply adds a border to the bottom of the module header. Remember, you can always combine suffixes together such as

tab3 b2

, which will produce a colored module title, with a colored background.

Number

is specifically designed for the menu module, adding a decimal list before the border graphic.

Flush will disable all padding and margin to the module for a tighter fit, with **FlushTop** and **FlushBottom**

disabling the margin/padding for the Top/Bottom parts of the module respectively.
